**Carlos Mendoza Davis signs the Collaboration and Participation Agreement with the Baja California Sur Community Alliance**

Carlos Mendoza Davis, Governor of Baja California Sur, signs a collaboration and participation agreement through the Secretary of Labor and Social Development, in representation of Gustavo Hernández Vela Kakogui and the Undersecretary Susana Zatarain García, with the Baja California Sur Community Alliance, represented by Lucía Frausto as the Coordinator of efforts for food sufficiency.

This agreement will make it possible to make a common and solidary front to the needs of the most vulnerable population of BCS, in order to share information as well as respond in a coordinated, transparent and joint way to the families that have been and will be affected by the economic crisis caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Therefore, through the DIF State System, the Secretary of Health, the Secretary of Labor and Social Development, as well as the 5 city councils and other nonprofit organizations will work together for the next three months.

The government and society come together in the face of this current health emergency, with the sum of efforts aimed at promoting citizenship participation; civil organizations, organized groups, foundations, trusts, citizens in general and the public and private sectors, will allow for generating economic or in-kind resources that mitigate the food needs that the BCS population requires during these difficult times.

There shall not be one habitant of Baja California Sur without food for the duration of the pandemic.
